

AMERICAN KALEIDOSCOPE – Berkeley Symphony – Berkeley, CA – October 15th

Nearly 28 years ago, pianist/composer Marcus
Roberts released his album *Portraits in Blue*. It was
anchored by his transformative interpretation of
George Gershwin's *Rhapsody in Blue*. At nearly
double the length of the original composition,
Roberts infused Gershwin's masterpiece with
harmonies and rhythms he didn't live long enough to
experience. In short, it's a brilliant work.

The Marcus Roberts Trio (Roland Guerin on bass and Jason Marsalis on drums) will play Rhapsody in Blue and also James P. Johnson's Yamekraw: A Negro Rhapsody at this concert.

Conductor Joseph Young leads the Berkeley Symphony in Samuel Barber's *Essay for Orchestra No.2* and Peter S. Shin's *Relapse* on the program as well.
